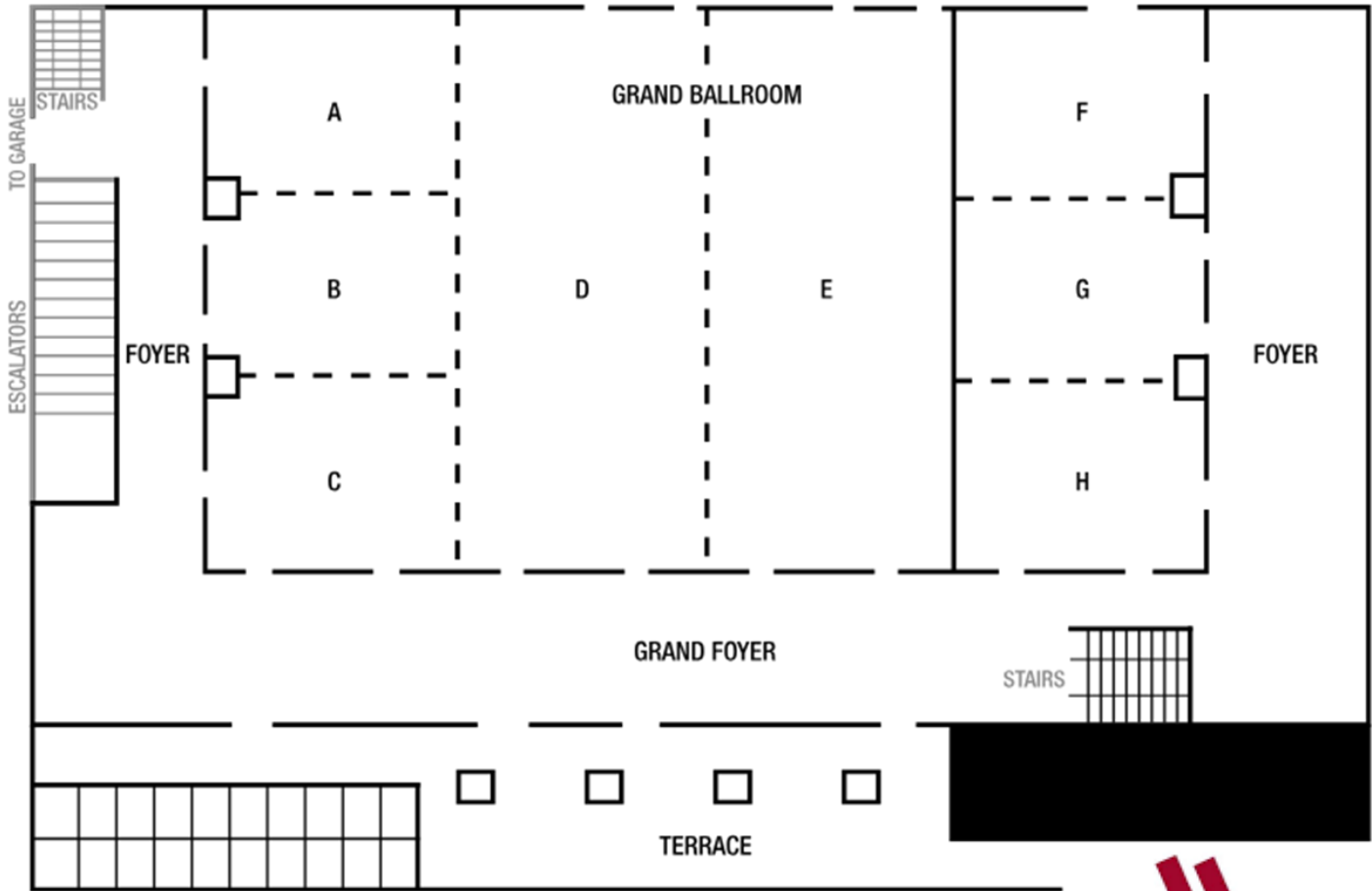

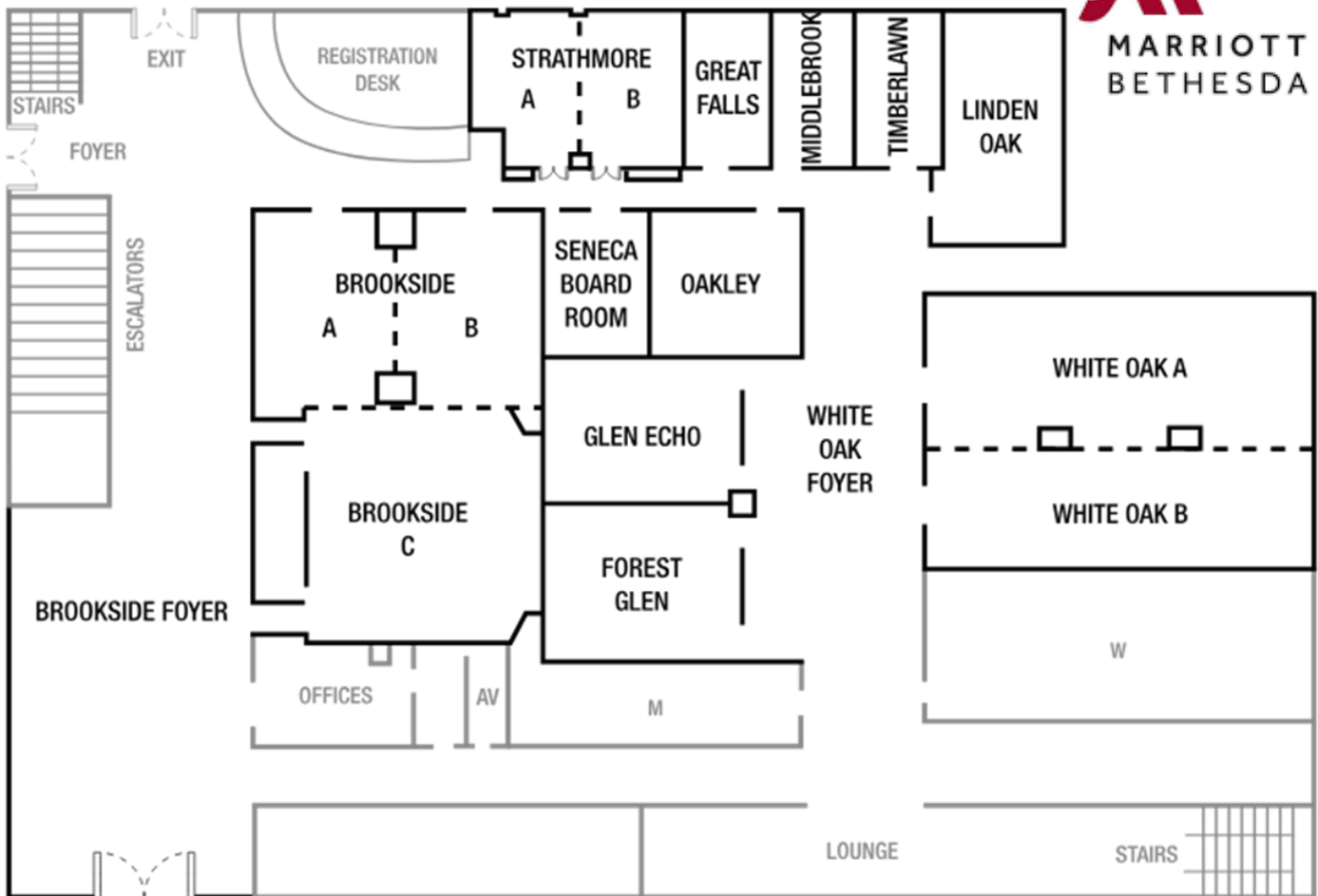

Once again, thank you for your support and prayers.

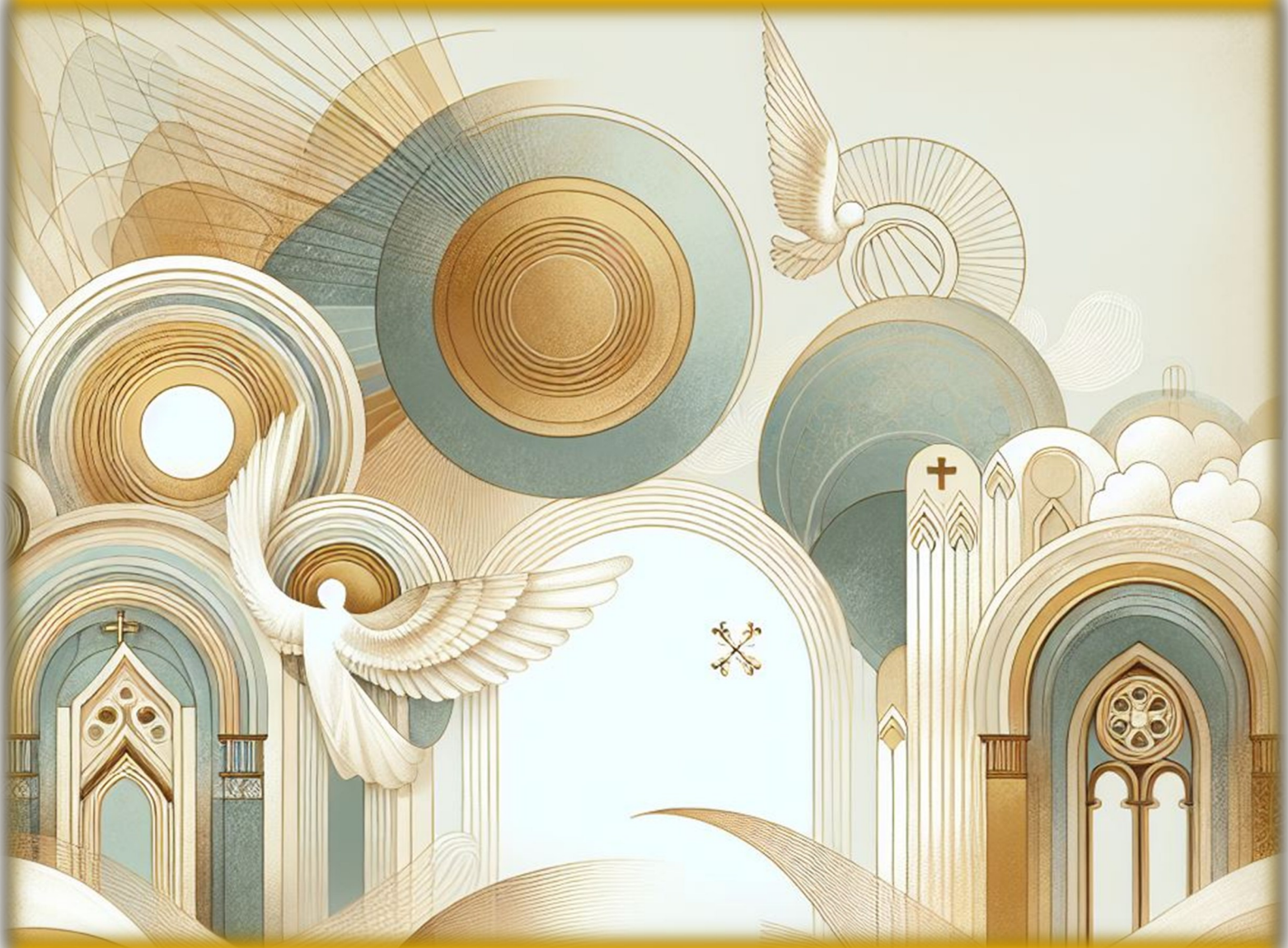
