Guidelines for Credential Certification

1. Officers listed on the Credentials Form should agree with your Council Roster submitted to the National Office. All members should be financial in his subordinate Council in order to participate in all State/ National Activities.
2. Deputy Grand Knights may be elected as a Delegate, if the Grand Knight is attending the Conference. You must specify on Credential form that the Deputy Grand Knight will be serving as part of the delegation from your council. If the Grand Knight is absent for any reason, The Deputy Grand Knight shall take his place and the Alternate Delegate selected shall take the place of the Deputy Grand Knight only if he is selected as a delegate.
3. Only the Grand Knight may certify the alternate replacement by signature or provide notice in writing in advance of Conference. If Knights submitted on Credential Form are unable to perform as delegates for the Texas State Conference due to unforeseen circumstances. It is the responsibility of the Grand Knight to submit in writing the changes of his delegation and submit them to the TSC President for approval. The TSC President must sign document for approval and attach to existing Credential Form for retention records. At no time shall a delegate be added to the Credentials without the acknowledgment and approval.
4. Article 1 Section 4 of the Texas State Council By-Laws entitles all Councils with less than 200 Members to 2 delegates and Councils with more than 200 members to 3 Delegates. This is in addition to the Grand Knight and Junior Knight Commander. If a Council does not have an active Jr. Knight Branch, a commander cannot be used as a delegate for the conference.
5. Texas State Conference By-Laws Article 1 Section 3 identifies the Texas State Council as Grand Knights, Commanders, Delegates, State Officers, Immediate Past President, Immediate Past State Deputy, Past Presidents, Past State Officers, and Past State Deputies.
6. A Commander/ Assistant Commander may only be used as part of your delegation if your unit has a Jr. Branch on record with the National Office. If your Council does not have an active Jr. Branch on record with the National Office, you are only entitled to Delegates on file minus Commander Position. Assistant Commanders can only vote if the Commander is absent or unable to cast his voting rights in the duration the conference.
7. All Credentials Forms shall be mailed in with the Official Council Seal and appropriate signatures affixed on document. If Council does not have seal, the Grand Knight and Financial Secretary **MUST** sign Credential Forms and must place in seal area "**NO SEAL AVAILABLE**". Failure to provide document without seal, may disqualify council and delegates from voting and participation in Texas State Council Meeting.
8. All Credential Forms not properly signed, sealed, or turned in by the set deadline will be returned to the Councils and **MAY NOT** be accepted but only at the approval of the Texas State Council Board of Directors.

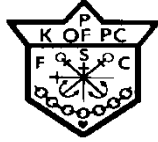

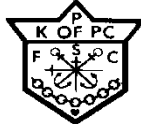

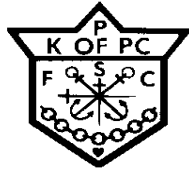

Award "B" Committee (Closed)

The committee receives and considers applications on behalf of candidates for the Texas State Conference Awards. It shall work in cooperation with a similar committee and shall report its decisions to the Conference. This is a closed committee. Prior to the conference, the President will appoint the committee for the process and selection of awards. This committee will meet, process, and select recipients for Conference Awards.

Budget and Finance

Audits the records of the State Financial Secretary and Treasurer and report their findings to the Council. The committee shall consider requests from the payment of bills and reimbursement of Members of Committees and State Officers, not authorized by law or by prior approval of the Council. The Budget and Finance Committee shall require the financial solvency of the Texas State Council.

ByLaws Revision (Closed)

This committees' purpose is to review the current revised Texas State Council By-Laws and examine them for compliance with the National Constitution and By-Laws of the Knights of Peter Claver, review document for grammatical and typographical errors, and investigate for regulatory compliance. This committee will bring their findings and recommendations to the Texas State Council.

Credentials

Examines credentials sent to the office of the State Financial Secretary to determine whether said credentials are in order to prepare the list of members for Roll Call. In addition, this Committee determines the voting strength for the Texas State Council Meeting in session.

Elections Committee (Closed)

This committee shall conduct the Elections of the Texas State Council and Office of State Deputy. The Committee shall be appointed at the conference and will adhere to all rules set by the committee and approved by the Texas State Council. The committee shall administer the nominations and elections and shall report the finding of the same. The Elections Committee will adhere to all timelines for the purposes of Nominations and Elections.

Greetings to the Ladies (Suspended until 2022)

This committee will recommend to the Council creative ways in which we honor and recognize the Ladies Division of the Texas State Conference. This committee shall inform the Texas State Treasurer prior to the conference their recommendation of what needs to be purchased, not to exceed \$200.00. In addition, this committee shall take up a collection during the conference of the Knights attending the conference.

Human Development

The committee recommends financial support by the Council to credible organizations that have as their purpose and programs, the improving for all citizens of our country quality of life.

Jr. Knights Commanders- (All Jr. Knight Commanders)

Considers legislation submitted by the State Branch of Junior Knights and reports their findings to assist the membership in the implementation of the National Junior Knight Program on the state and local level.

Officer's Report (Suspended until 2022)

Reviews the written reports of the State Officers and report their findings to the Conference.

Organization and Development (State Deputy and All Area Deputies) (Closed)

Interprets the National Programs for organization and development and assist the membership in the implementation of these programs on a local level.

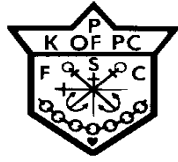
Rules and Steering Committee

Joint Committee Assignments

Church Relations Committee

Enhance the spirituality of the Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies Auxiliary as it relates to their various parishes and the services provided by the Church.

Joint Charity Committee (Suspended until 2022)

This Committee monitors and compiles the Charitable Hours and Works of the Councils and Courts of Texas and reports their findings to the Texas State Conference in session.

Evaluations Committee

Assist membership with completing the electronic evaluation, accumulate results and report on the responses, including strengths and weaknesses.

Emerging Leaders

The committee is comprised of members age 18-35. The Emerging Leaders provide community service and mentor Junior members who are preparing to transfer to the senior division.

Joint Audit Committee

Provide financial audit of joint financial books. Reports findings and recommendations to the Joint Assembly at Annual Conference.

Jr. Commanders & Counselors

Give updates on the Junior Conference and events. Discuss Junior Division members concerns and make recommendations as needed. This committee includes all Jr. Knight Commanders and Jr. Daughter Counselors.

George "Mickey" Leland Food Drive (Suspended until 2022)

A project established by the Texas State Conference to continue the works started by the late Congressman, George "Mickey" Leland in providing food to the less fortunate. This committee is

composed of all Grand Knights and Grand Ladies. This committee compiles information provided by the Councils and Courts of Texas, enumerating the total amount in poundage of food and total dollar amount of money donate

Medical Care Team

This committee will consist of Knights and Ladies who are in healthcare professions. This committees' responsibility is to assist conference attendees who may be experiencing health issues that require medical attention. The Medical Care Team will also compile information and make recommendations to the Texas State Conference that will greatly affect the quality and improvement of life for all Clavers in the State of Texas. This committee should be certified and trained in CPR/ Life Saving Techniques.

All Licensed Healthcare Professionals/ Caregivers are encouraged to participate in this committee.

TSC Security Team (Jr. Texas State Conference) (Closed)

This committee convenes during the annual Junior Texas State Conference. The committee serves as security for the Junior Texas State Conference. Members of the KPC Security team are appointed by the TSC Presidents. All members of the KPC Security Committee must complete training consistent with *Veritas Protecting God's Children* or other training certified by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Documentation of successful completion of this form of training must be made available to the Texas State Conference prior to participation on this committee. The 1st Vice President of the Texas State Council shall serve as advisor to this committee.

Special Projects Committee (All Past State Officers) (Closed)

This Committee serves as an Ad Hoc committee to the Texas State Conference. The Texas State Presidents define the committees charge, purpose, and length of service. The Special Projects Committee seeks to address timely societal, educational, health, and economic events with a particular consideration on issues affecting African-American Catholics. The TSC President may also convene the Special Projects committee in response to directives issued by the National Board of the Knights of Peter Claver.

Technology Committee

The Technology Committee promotes the use of technology to increase efficiency of conference operations. The Committee assess the technological needs and competences of the conference attendees by assisting the membership with completing electronic evaluations and electronic voting.

Texas Clavers Fighting Cancer Committee

This committee works to raise funds to research and fight Cancer in the communities of the Texas State Conference. The committee collects gifts and money donated from Councils and Courts for a silent auction and placed in a dedicated room. All proceeds from that auction, are donated to a cause for cancer research and awareness=

Texas State Scholarship Committee

Monitors and assess the progress of state scholarship recipients and programs. Scholarships are given to 2 individuals who are graduating seniors who are pursuing technical and vocational careers.

Final approval for disbursement of funds are voted on by the Texas State Conference Board of Directors and the recipient will be announced and presented funds during the Texas State Conference Annual meeting

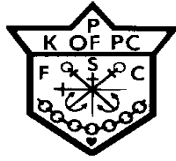
Veterans (Suspended until 2022)

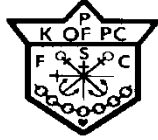
